Shasta on the expenditure, investment, or encumbrance of revenues raised from the Library Transactions and Use Tax. The Committee will also review and make recommendations to the City Council on the operations of the Library as they may relate to the expenditure of those revenues. The Committee will serve as a forum for the free exchange of information and ideas relating to Library issues.
